You must be registered and attend the conference to receive payment of the award.

Applications: To be considered for a travel award, fill out the questionnaire, get your advisor's signature on it, and send it to the address below. The deadline for receipt of applications to be considered is **Friday**, **September 24**th.

Mechanics of awards: Processing of applications and notification of recipients will begin shortly after September 24th so you can make travel arrangements. Awards will be applied to registration fees and the balance will be paid by check at the meeting. Students must be registered and attend the conference to qualify for payment of the award. You need not be registered at the time of your application, but your registration fee will be based on when you register, so we recommend that you register early to reduce registration rates. You must be in attendance at the meeting to collect your check. Sorry, no advanced payments.
